

## **PPC RULES & REGULATIONS**

**CIAC RULES APPLY WITH THE EXCEPTION OF PPC RULES & REGULATIONS**

### **GAME RULES:**

- \*UNSPORTSMAN LIKE CONDUCT WILL NOT BE TOLERATED BY PLAYERS, COACHES, STAFF, & PARENTS!**
- \*Two 18 minutes halves with running time, clock stops during foul shots, time-outs, injuries, on the whistle with two minutes left in each half, and referee's discretion.**
- \*Mercy rule: If a team is up by 20 or more points during second half the clock remains running except for timeouts and referees discretion.**
- \*No one and one foul shots, two foul shots on and after the tenth foul of each half.**
- \*4 minute pre-game warm-up, 3minute half time break, if time permits.**
- \*2 minute overtime period (Time permitting) one full timeout per-overtime, no carry overs.**
- \*One full and two thirty second timeout per-half no carry over to next half or overtime.**
- \*No more than two coaches and one bookkeeper allowed on the bench during game, only the head coach can leave his seat staying within the coaching box during game.**
- \*Girls will play with 28.5 basketball; Boys will play with 29.5 basketball.**
- \*Home team must provide official bookkeeper.**
- \*Visiting team must operate game clock.**
- \*Team must have 5 players to the start game, Team must be ready to play at scheduled time or game will be considered a forfeit for the team that does not have five players.**
- \*Teams are required to play their scheduled games.**
- \*Teams must provide their own warm-up basketballs.**
- \*Game jersey must have visible numbers on back.**
- \*Home team wears white or light jerseys.**

## **PPC LEAGUE RULES**

**\*NO AAU TEAMS ALLOWED!**

**\*5<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> grade players must be no older than 12 years of age until 12/31/13.**

**\*7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> grade players must be no older than 14 years of age until 12/31/13.**

**\*Final team roster is due before first league game.**

**\*No more than 14 players on roster.**

**\*5<sup>th</sup> graders can play up to 6<sup>th</sup> grade team and play on the A & B teams for the same town, 7<sup>th</sup> grades can play up to 8<sup>th</sup> grade team and play on the A & B teams for the same town.**

**\*Each player, coach, and staff member must fill out and hand in waiver/disclaimer, registration forms before first scheduled game. DO NOT HAND IN BIRTH CERTIFICATES, THEY ARE FOR VIEWING ONLY AT REGISTRATION.**

**\*Players must live in town represented by team, with the exception of small towns that cannot fill their roster. Small towns that cannot fill their roster can have no more than a total of three players from the combined surrounding border towns (not three players per-town) that do not have teams represented in a PPC division.**

**\*If a player moves to a different town during the season he or she can play for the same team they originally registered with.**

**\*PPC committee reserves the right to verify all information on registration forms.**

**\*No team entry fee or general admission fee for players, coaches, bookkeepers, & game clock operators at any PPC game including teams that are hosting home games.**

**\*Team that forfeit game must pay \$80 for each game they forfeit before they resume play.**

**\*Teams must travel to game location listed on their schedule.**

**\*Teams can host their home games at their own facility at their own cost.**

**\*Teams that forfeit games not played at Mashantucket community center must pay all cost incurred by host team.**

**\*Teams that host home games must supply certified referees.**

**\*Teams that host home games must host them on Saturdays or Sundays.**

**\*Teams that host home games cannot have a general admission of more than \$2 if they wish to charge general admissions to non-players and staff.**

**\*50% of league raffle ticket sales go to PPC.**

**\*PPC is not responsible for lost items.**

**\*ALL DECISIONS BY PPC COMMITTEE ARE FINAL.**
